Freedom Valley Campground

Rules & Regulations

- Age to camp at Freedom Valley Campground is 21 or older. If a reservation is made and you are found to be under 21 at check in, your reservation will be refused without refund.
- 2. **Camping equipment** per lot is limited to one RV and one tent.
- Gate Code is given only to guests who have registered and paid to enter the park. Anyone caught giving out the gate code to a nonregistered guest may be asked to leave the park without refund.
- **4. Campfires** must be attended at all times. All fires must be kept within the fire pit, fire ring or fireplace. You may not have a fire on the property that exceeds 3 feet. All fires must be extinguished prior to leaving the property. During time of fire restrictions, no fires of any type are permitted. **PLEASE DO NOT move the fire rings**.
- 5. **Firewood** is not allowed to be brought into Wisconsin from another state and all firewood must be bought within a 10 mile radius of Freedom Valley Campground to control the spread of disease. Firewood is sold on site for your convenience.
- 6. **Dangerous materials** are not allowed on the property or in the campground.
- 7. **Firearms** are not allowed on the premises of Freedom Valley Campground
- 8. No clotheslines allowed
- 9. **Littering** is prohibited in every area of the campground.
- 10. **Speed limit** in the park is 10 miles per hour. Everyone is responsible for compliance with the speed limit in the Campground. No one shall drive motor vehicles on the grass. Failure to follow the speed limit will result in a \$25 fine.
- 11. **No means No** and all unruly, rowdy, immoral and intolerable behavior will not be allowed on the property or in the Campground. All campers are required to conduct themselves in a respectable manner.
- 12. **Cameras/Photos** are allowed as long as all parties taking the photo and the parties in the photo agree to allow the picture to be taken. Please be respectful of others privacy.
- 13. All campers and visitors are to respect campground property. You are responsible for reporting any unusual occurrences. Any person compromising another camper's privileges will have their camping privileges revoked immediately without refund.
- 14. **Pets must be kept on a leash,** cleaned up after and not left unattended. No pets allowed in check in building, restrooms, pavilion, and any other public building. Owner's are responsible for any claim, loss or damage caused by their pet(s).
- 15. Parking is limited to your own site. If there is not enough room, you must park extra vehicles in the public parking lot.
- 16. Alcohol is permitted throughout the campground. Excessive use will not be tolerated. Drug use will be reported to the authorities. We reserve the right to remove you from your campsite without a refund.
- 17. Glass containers are not permitted at the campground. ALL GLASS CONTAINERS WILL BE CONFISCATED!
- 18. **Cigarette Butts** are not to be thrown on the ground. Please dispose of butts safely.
- 19. Solicitation, prostitution, and negotiation of payment for sexual services are illegal and will NOT be tolerated.
- 20. Fireworks are not permitted without a written consent from the owners.
- 21. **Back Flow Preventers** are not to be removed. Removal will incur a \$25 fine. If we are inspected by the state at a time when a back flow preventer is missing due to your actions, you will be charged a \$400 fine in accordance with state code.
- 22. **Pond Rules** No lifeguard on duty, swim at your own risk. Liner may be slippery so be careful! Diving and jumping is prohibited. No pets allowed on the beach or in pond. No glass containers allowed. No fires near the pond/on the beach. Stay out of plant life (bog) area. Chairs are for public use, but please put them away after use.
- 23. Neither Freedom Valley Campground, LLC, it's officers, staff, enrollees, guests or all other persons and entities which may sponsor, promote, operate, own or manage the campground shall be liable to any attendees for injury to person or property incurred as a result of attendance.
